



Due to the nature of the event and the venue ALL people who attend must be pre-registered

Please NOTE: NO under 16s will be allowed on the stages unless previously notified
You will be required to provide a form of photo identification at Sign-on
(Passport/Driving licence or MSA Marshal licence)

IF YOU HAVE NOT PRE-REGISTERED YOU WILL NOT BE ABLE TO MARSHAL

First of all I would like to thank RallyStageTeam for their assistance in setting up the pre-registration system and for providing use of their site at no charge to RBMR 09.

Secondly, but of no less importance, my thanks to all of you who have volunteered to support the RBMR 09, in whatever capacity, as marshals – Stage, Radio, Rescue and Recovery.

These Instructions are intended to help you enjoy the weekend by clearly advising what you should do:

ARRIVAL: Entry for all will be through Crash Gate 5, which is off Chalk Lane, off the A1122 (Swaffham Road). GR744 086. SAT Nav directions using the postcode PE33 9NP will take you to the wrong entrance.

DO NOT attempt entry through the Main Station Entrance

Follow the Richard Burns Memorial Rally Signs to Crash Gate 5 and anticipate being directed to the right lane as you pass through the gates. RAF security personnel will separate spectators and 'officials' through use of the car passes that have been printed at the bottom of your signing-on cards.

It is important that the pass is displayed in your car window as you approach the security personnel and that all occupants have the passes available for inspection. Do not attempt to enter if someone in your group has not been pre-registered; they will be refused entry at the gate and they will NOT be signed on.

The attached map shows the route, that will be signposted, to take you to Sign-On and the Service Park/Camping area.

The Crash Gate will open and close promptly at the times given – do not ask to be let in/out if the gates are closed

SIGN-ON:

Personnel will be required to sign-on personally on Sat and Sun. There will not be a sign-on Fri. At sign-on your car pass will be exchanged for a Marshal sticker, which will enable you to gain entry to the stage. We also have a small selection of gifts and foodstuffs. A marshal's Prize draw will be held, each day, immediately after sign-on closes; results will be announced during the event.

Once signed-on, please proceed to the Service Park/stage start and drive to your allocated post.

EQUIPMENT

Please bring clothing appropriate to the weather conditions
– Airfields can be cold and windy even in the best of weather

Radio Crews are requested to bring Red Flags if available.
ALL Marshals should bring their own tabards as event specific tabards will not be available.

FOOD/DRINK

Marshals will be provided with some foodstuffs but these are intended to supplement your own supplies

A Burger van will be accessible for breakfast and during the planned lunchbreak

PARTY ON THE PAN

Marshals who attend Sat and Sun will be provided with a free ticket to the Party on the Pan (Sat Night). These will be issued at Sign on ONLY to those who sign-on
