RBMR Campsite Fire Orders:

FIRE PRECAUTIONS - TENTED CAMPS

1.
 - a. All visitors using the campsite are to familiarise themselves with Fire Points within the campsite.
 - b. Tents and Caravans should be pitched 6 meters apart.
 - c. No naked lights (eg candles) are permitted in tents.
 - d. No lights of any description are to be left unattended in any tent.
 - e. No exterior BBQ's are permitted.
 - f. No flammable liquids are to be stored in tents.
 - g. Cooking under canvas is not permitted.
 - h. Where smoking is permitted, cigarette ends, spent matches are to be placed into suitable receptacles containing earth, sand or water and not carelessly discarded at the designated smoking area.
 - i. Open Fires in the vicinity of tents are forbidden.
 - j. Fire buckets are to be kept filled with water or sand where issued and are not to be removed or used for any other purpose than fire fighting.
2. The following notes on fire fighting in tented lines are issued for the guidance of all concerned:
 - a. Note the wind direction.
 - b. Where practicable, cut the guy ropes so that the tent(s) will fall into the wind, thus tending to smother the fire.
 - c. Operate extinguishers and/or fire buckets.
 - d. Strike tents in the vicinity to prevent the spread of fire.
